

SRAP 008: A License to Thrill

Awards and Recognition



Institutional Programming Award—This award is presented to the institution that stands out above the rest for programming at SRAP. This is determined by a combination of the proportion of programs to delegates AND the evaluation scores of these programs. (Details for calculations will be available at SRAP.)

Spirit Stick—This award is presented to the institution that is most involved at SRAP. Points will be awarded for participation in a variety of activities, including:

- percentage of delegation presenting programs
- Participation in agent video/slide show
- Submission of a Sample Name Tag
- Participation in the philanthropy (institution donating to House of Ruth)
- Donation of items for giveaways (school shirts, bags, mugs, etc.)
- Bringing spirit giveaways (give items to delegates from other schools to get to know them and share your spirit with them. NO stickers or other items that could in any way damage property are permitted. No guns, toy or otherwise, are permitted.)
- Positive attitude and spirit throughout the event
(institution may gain points for positive attitude and spirit or lose points for negative attitude and spirit, such as booing, delegates not attending programs during sessions, etc.)

Top Passive Program Award—This award is presented to the individual who presents the best passive program. This will be determined by a group of judges.

Superior Agent Dossier: Top Video Award—This award is presented to the school with the best video or slide show. It is recommended that videos and slide shows play with this year's theme: SRAP 008: A License to Thrill. However, these videos may not include any guns or simulations of violence and weapons. Please see the newsletter for additional information. The winning Agent video will be determined by the SRAP Committee.

Superior Agent Training: Top Ten Program Awards—These awards will be presented to the individuals who present the Top Ten Programs. This will be determined by a combination of program attendance and evaluation scores. (Attendees from the presenter's school are not counted in this and should not complete evaluations.)

Diversity/Affirmative Action Committee Awards—These awards will be presented to all program presenters who address topics of Diversity or Affirmative Action.
